

Indoor Court Regulations - Short Version

Status: 02.01.2026

1. General

- The purpose of these regulations is to ensure orderly match operations and well-maintained indoor facilities
- They apply to all users (members & non-members) present in the hall; instructions from the board or the court attendant must be followed

2. Booking & Use

- **Reservations:** Only courts booked through the online system "Sportision" may be used
- **Participants:** For insurance reasons, the person making the booking must list all players for each reservation
- **Cancellation of single bookings:** Free of charge up to 72 hours before the start of play
- **Problems:** In case of technical issues, please report immediately

- **Payment:** Generally by direct debit from the person making the booking – each player is charged proportionally according to their membership status
Booking rights may be suspended in case of payment delays or violations (e.g., booking on behalf of third parties)

3. Indoor Court Rules

- **Equipment:** Only clean indoor tennis shoes and appropriate tennis clothing are allowed.
No street shoes or clay-court shoes!
- **Cleanliness:** Drag the court after playing (attention: signal tone 5 minutes before the end) and leave it clean (remove waste, empty bottles, cans, etc.)
- **Safety:** No access with glass items; animals, smoking, and bringing your own alcoholic beverages are prohibited
- **Youth Protection:** Selling or handing out tobacco and alcohol to minors is forbidden (under 16: beer, wine; under 18: spirits, etc.)

4. Safety and Technology

- Only authorized persons may use the indoor courts – doors must be kept closed at all times
- Do not adjust technical equipment (heating, ventilation, etc.)
- In case of malfunctions (e.g., lighting or heating failure), please notify the board or court attendant immediately (technik@tcaurachtal.de)

5. Sanktionen

- Violations (e.g., unauthorized use, incorrect booking, non-compliance with these regulations) may result in penalties of up to €250 and temporary suspension of booking rights (up to 14 days)
- Repeated unsportsmanlike behavior may lead to warnings, playing bans, or even expulsion from the club

The board calls for fairness, consideration, and proper use of the indoor courts – suggestions for improvement are always welcome
